Work activities

- arranging vehicle maintenance, MOTs and tax payments
- organising vehicle replacements
- managing contracts and developing new business
- you will be organising & planning routes with the office, liaison with the dispatch and customer service departments.
- you would also make sure that all operations are carried out in line with UK and EU laws and regulations. These govern vehicle safety, controls on fuel emissions, driver hours

Working hours and conditions
